

# Direct deposit your 2008 IRS tax refund to any or all of your checking, savings, and IRA accounts



You can now designate the account information and amounts for each allocation for a split refund on **Form 8888**. You may also continue to use the U.S. Individual Income Tax Return form to send your refund to one account.

There are only two requirements for direct deposit: Your account number(s), which are shown on your statement, and our routing number **123456789**.



Note: Members filing Form 1040-EZ-T, claim for Refund of Federal Telephone Excise Tax, or Form 8379 Injured Spouse Allocation cannot opt to split their refunds. Taxpayers also cannot direct their funds into the accounts of others, except in the case of joint accounts.
