



Working with **ABC Credit Union**, the IRS will transmit your refund directly **to up to three of your credit union accounts** such as checking, savings, and retirement accounts. Split refund direct deposit gives you **safety** and **speed** and it encourages **savings**.

With this **new convenient option** you can now designate the account information and amounts for each allocation for a split refund on **Form 8888**. You may also continue to use the U.S. Individual Income Tax Return form to send your refund to one account.

There are only two requirements for direct deposit:

- Your account number(s), which are shown on your statement
- Our routing number: **123456789**

It's **safe**. It's **speedy**. And it will help members **save**.



Note: Members filing Form 1040-EZ-T, claim for Refund of Federal Telephone Excise Tax, or Form 8379 Injured Spouse Allocation cannot opt to split their refunds. Taxpayers also cannot direct their funds into the accounts of others, except in the case of joint accounts.
